DIRECTIONS TO SIDDHACHALAM

New Entrance from 111 Hope Road

Siddhachalam will have one-way traffic on August 6 and 7. Entrance will be from 111 Hope Road only (exit from 65 Mud Pond Road). It is much easier to get into Siddhachalam from 111 Hope Road. Stay on Hope Road (County Road 521) for 2.8 miles after taking exit 12 on Route 80 and Siddhachalam is on the right. No turns, no by-lanes, no need to ask for directions! Good for us, good for the town!
